

Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage (National Offshore Petroleum Titles Administrator) Approved Manner of Execution of Notices 2026 No. 1

Approved manner for execution of notices for the purposes of the Offshore Petroleum Greenhouse Gas Storage Act 2006 (the OPGGS Act) and the Offshore Petroleum and Greenhouse Gas Storage (Resource Management and Administration) Regulations 2025 (the RMA Regulations)

I, Graeme Waters, the National Offshore Petroleum Titles Administrator, under subsection 33(3) of the *Acts Interpretation Act 1901*, sections 775B, 775C and 775CA of the OPGGS Act, and sections 218 and 219 of the RMA Regulations.

APPROVE the following manner of execution for each of the notices specified below:

- 1) for the purposes of section 775B of the OPGGS Act, in relation to a joint written notice, for nomination of one of the joint registered holders of a petroleum title as being the person who is authorised to take eligible voluntary actions on behalf of the registered holders, the manner set out in **Schedule 1**;
- 2) for the purposes of section 775C of the OPGGS Act, in relation to a joint written notice, for nomination of one of the joint registered holders of a greenhouse gas title as being the person who is authorised to take eligible voluntary actions on behalf of the registered holders, the manner set out in **Schedule 1**;
- 3) for the purposes of section 775CA of the OPGGS Act, in relation to a joint written notice, for nomination of one of the joint registered holders of a cross-boundary greenhouse gas title as being the person who is authorised to take eligible voluntary actions on behalf of the registered holders, the manner set out in **Schedule 1**;
- 4) for the purposes of section 218 of the RMA Regulations, in relation to a joint written notice, for nomination of one of the joint registered holders of a petroleum title as being the person to whom documents may be given on behalf of the registered holders, the manner set out in **Schedule 1**;
- 5) for the purposes of section 219 of the RMA Regulations, in relation to a joint written notice, for nomination of one of the joint registered holders of a greenhouse gas title as being the person to whom documents may be given on behalf of the registered holders, the manner set out in **Schedule 1**.

This Approval has effect from 31 March 2026.
