

Manner of lodging an application under subsection 39A(1) of the OEI Regulations (application for consent to surrender licence), giving a notice under subsection 39A(2) of the OEI Regulations, and giving a report under subsection 33(6) (final report) of the OEI Regulations.

The lodgement of an application is to be made on the approved form found at https://www.offshoreregistrar.gov.au in the following ways:

- 1. By sending the application to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar by email to: offshoreelectricity@nopta.gov.au; or
- 2. By accessing an account in the NEATS Secure Portal (the Portal) on the website of https://secure.neats.nopta.gov.au, and submitting the application in the Portal, or
- 3. By prepaying and posting the application, in hard copy or on a USB, addressed to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar to:
