Manner of lodging applications under section 21 (transmission and infrastructure licence – applications) of the Regulations

The lodgement of an application is to be made on the approved form found at <u>https://www.offshoreregistrar.gov.au</u> in the following ways:

- 1. By sending the application to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar by email to: <u>offshoreelectricity@nopta.gov.au; or</u>
- 2. By accessing an account in the NEATS Secure Portal (**the Portal**) on the website of <u>https://secure.neats.nopta.gov.au</u>, and submitting the application in the Portal, or
- 3. By prepaying and posting the application, in hard copy or on a USB, addressed to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar to:

4. By leaving the application in hard copy or on USB at an office occupied by the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, or by APS employees assisting the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, during business hours.
