1. By sending the application to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar by email to: offshoreelectricity@nopta.gov.au, or
2. By accessing an account in the NEATS Secure Portal (**the Portal**) on the website of <https://secure.neats.nopta.gov.au>, and submitting the application in the Portal, or
3. By prepaying and posting the application, in hard copy or on a USB, addressed to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar to:
 - Perth Office – GPO Box 7871, PERTH WA 6850, or
 - Melbourne Office – GPO Box 4634, MELBOURNE VIC 3001, or
4. By leaving the application in hard copy or on a USB at an office occupied by the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, or by APS employees assisting the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, during business hours.
