Manner of lodging applications under section 35 (application to transfer a licence) of the Offshore Electricity Infrastructure Regulations 2022

The lodgement of an application is to be made using the approved form found at https://www.offshoreregistrar.gov.au in the following ways:

- 1. By sending the application to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar by email to: offshoreelectricity@nopta.gov.au, or
- 2. By accessing an account in the NEATS Secure Portal (the Portal) on the website of https://secure.neats.nopta.gov.au, and submitting the application in the Portal, or
- 3. By prepaying and posting the application, in hard copy or on a USB, addressed to the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar to:
 - Perth Office GPO Box 7871, PERTH WA 6850, or
 - Melbourne Office GPO Box 4634, MELBOURNE VIC 3001, or
- 4. By leaving the application in hard copy or on a USB at an office occupied by the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, or by APS employees assisting the Offshore Infrastructure Registrar, during business hours.
